1 Corinthians 7:32-34

- There are many unmarried who feel as if their lives are in a holding pattern.
- Many fear that they are missing out on God’s plan or God’s best for their lives because they are not married.
- The church is suffering because it has picked up the world’s definition of the unmarried and has called them single.
- To be unmarried means to be without a spouse or to not be married.
- Intent: to help us to understand what God’s view on the subject of being unmarried.
- Purpose: to prevent people from making the same mistakes that many have made in the past.
- Goal: to show that you don’t have to be married to live a fulfilled life.
- There is a huge difference between being single and unmarried in God’s point of view.
- Many people have never been single, even though he or she may have been unmarried.
- To be single means: to be separated, unique, and whole.
- To be totally single should be every Christian’s number one goal.

- **No one should marry unless they are totally single.**
- **Many people still think that getting married is the key to fulfillment and happiness.**
- **Real fulfillment, success, and happiness can only be found in the Lord Jesus Christ.**
- **In Genesis 2:18, God did not say, “It was not good for man to be single.” He said, “It is not good that man should be alone.”**
- **In essence, God said, “I am going to make Adam a helper who will be fit and adaptable, and suitable, or someone like him.**
- **Being single is essential to and the foundation of all relationships.**
